The University invites online applications for admission to 2 year integrated Master of Library and Information Science (dual degree: B.Lib.I.Sc + M.Lib.I.Sc.), B.Ed. Special Education in Visual Impairment, B.Ed. Special Education in Hearing Impairment, Diploma in Tagore Literature and Post Graduate Diploma in Manuscriptology and Palaeography (PGDMP) programme under the Faculty of Arts in the session 2025-2026.

Application Forms can be filled up **Online** on the University admission portal https://online.rbu.net.in from 08/08/2025 to 20/08/2025.

Academic Programme:

1) 2 year integrated Master of Library and Information Science {(B.Lib.I.Sc. 1-year duration consisting of 2 Semester of 6-months each) + (M.Lib.I.Sc 1-year duration consisting of 2 Semester of 6-months each.)}:

A) Eligibility criteria for admission

(a) For Fresher candidates:

Any person having Graduation with honours (10+2+3 pattern) or Master's degree (with honours) or a technical/Professional degree (of the pattern 10+2+4 or 10+2+5 or 10+2+3+2 or 10+2+3+2+2) such as Engineering, Computer Application, Pharmacy, Law, Education etc. of any U.G.C recognized University or Institute.

(b) For Deputed candidates:

Graduation with honours and working experience as a full-time salaried staff in any Govt./ Govt. aided Libraries/recognized institution (Govt. or semi Govt.).

(C) For Certificate -holders in Library Science:

Graduation with honours with certificate in Library Science.

B) Break of studies for Fresher candidates:

Fresher candidates having break of studies for more than two years would not be eligible for admission i.e. the last degree obtained should not be prior to 2023.

The condition of break of studies is not applicable to Deputed candidates.

In **2 year integrated Master of Library and Information Science course**, 04 (four) seats are reserved for Foreign / NRI students against a higher rate of tuition fees. In case of non-availability of Foreign / NRI students, Indian students may be considered in those seats against the same higher rate of tuition fees.

C) Admission Procedures: Admission to this programme will be made on basis of the performance in admission test and academic score.

D) Preparation of Merit Lists:

How to Convert:

In order to convert the marks to credit marks, % (percentage) of marks obtained in any examination be divided by 100 and multiplied by the highest marks allotted in the self- assessment form e.g. an applicant obtaining 60 % marks in Madhyamik Examination be divided by 100 and multiplied by 10 to get Grade marks of 6.

ii) Admission Test: 50

Aggregate of the total score (i) + (ii) = total score) will be counted towards preparation of the provisional merit lists.

MCQ based Admission test will be made on General Knowledge, General Arithmetic, General English, Current Affairs and Basic Computer Knowledge.

2) B.Ed. Special Education in Visual Impairment (B.Ed. Spl. Ed. In V.I.)

Eligibility criteria for admission:

- a. Candidates with at least 50% (45% for SC/ST/OBC/PH) marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's degree in Social Sciences/Humanities/ Sciences, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% (50% for SC/ST/OBC/PH) marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.
- b. **Break-of-Studies:** Fresher candidates having break of studies for more than two years (i.e. the last degree obtained should not be prior to 2023) would not be eligible for admission.

3) B.Ed. Special Education in Hearing Impairment (B.Ed. Spl. Ed. in H.I.)

Eligibility criteria for admission:

- a. Candidates with at least 50% (45% for SC/ST/OBC/PH) marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's degree in Social Sciences/Humanities/ Sciences, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% (50% for SC/ST/OBC/PH) marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.
- b. **Break-of-Studies:** Fresher candidates having break of studies for more than two years (i.e. the last degree obtained should not be prior to 2023) would not be eligible for admission.

4) Diploma in Tagore Literature: (1 - year)

- a) **Minimum Eligibility:** Madhyamik or its equivalent. Students from any stream with Graduate or Post-Graduate qualifications may also apply.
- b) **Admission Procedure**: Admission to the Diploma in Tagore Literature will be taken according to the marks obtained in Madhyamik or its equivalent. To apply under sports Quota Minimum Eligibility will be Higher Secondary.

5) Post Graduate Diploma Course in Manuscriptology and Palaeography(PGDMP) :(1-year)

- a) Eligibility: Master's degree in any subject from any UGC recognized University. (Knowledge in Sanskrit and Devanagari script will be Desirable).
- b) **Admission Procedure:** Admission to the PG Diploma Course in Manuscriptlogy and Palaeography will be taken according to the marks obtained in Master's degree or its equivalent. Knowledge in Sanskrit and Devanagari script is predominant.

Reservation of Seats

Reservation of seats for the reserved categories will be as per the Rules/ Regulations/ Notifications etc. published / issued by the competent authority of the Government time to time in this regard. Reserved category candidate from the state other than West Bengal will be treated as unreserved category

Exercise of Option:

As per Govt. Rules, the candidates belonging to reserved categories (SC/ST/OBC) who have found place in the general merit list on the basis of their merit will also be placed in the merit list for the reserved categories of candidates. It is mandatory for such candidates to exercise their option on whether they would like to be placed in the general merit list or the separate merit list for reserved categories of candidates. Admission would be made as per the option exercised by the candidates. The option once exercised shall not be altered under any circumstances.

How to Apply:

The applicants are advised to follow the instructions noted hereunder while filling upthe Application Forms online:

- In order to apply online, applicants have to register themselves first.
- During registration, applicant will be asked to provide an e-mail id and a mobile number, these must be valid ones because initial login password will be sent to the provided e- mail id and mobile number via SMS, and in future, all correspondences in this regard may be made to these e-mail id and the given mobile no. via SMS
- Applicants must provide valid email id & mobile number. else the registration process will not be completed.
- After registration, the password will be sent to the registered e-mail id and mobile number.
- It is recommended that the applicant should change their password on the first log in, if required.
- After successful login, applicant will be required to select course(s) he / she may wish to apply and check the eligibility first. Once found eligible he / she can fill up rest of the Admission Form
- An applicant will be required to upload scanned copy of mark sheet of Higher Secondary and Hons. examination, his/her scanned Photograph and Signature during filling up the admission form, therefore, he/she is advised to keep these ready before filling up the admission form.
- If the applicant does not have all required information at the time of filling the form, he/she can save the incomplete application as a draft (by clicking on 'Next' or 'Previous' button) and log out. Later, by login back to his/her account again he/she may complete the rest of application form.
- After filling up all required information to submit the same, applicant must agree with the given declaration, clicking on check box. It is important to note that, once it is submitted, the information already entered cannot be altered under any circumstances. Therefore, they are advised to be sure about the accuracy and relevance of the filled up information before clicking the **submit** button.

- 6. Admission of a candidate will be cancelled if any information given by him/her is found to be wrong or suppressed.
- 7. Submission of application Forms for admission does not imply any right to admission and selection for admission does not assure accommodation in UniversityHostels.
- 8. The list of the Candidates selected for interview/written test /admission will generally be treated as cancelled as soon as the corresponding last date is over.
- 9. Duly filled-in downloaded application form should be signed by the candidate and his/her parent/guardian at the given spaces of the form.
